

Spring Session 2 Class Schedule, May 15 through June 23 (Six-Week Session)

Our Spring Session II has classes for many levels of proficiency. Not sure what level to take? Take the online placement test on our web site aftucson.com. If joining a numbered class in progress, please contact us during office hours or talk to the instructor about how to get caught up. **Minimum enrollment is four students per class.** Our numbered classes require a Latitudes textbook and workbook, which cost \$60 and can be purchased in our office.

Classes for beginning students (100-level classes)

Level A1 101B	Once a week: 6-8 PM Mondays with Olivier Beginning French foundation class continues from Spring Session Term 1. <i>Cost: \$115 members/\$165 non-members for six weeks (uses Latitudes 1 books)</i>
Level A1 102A	Once a week: 6-8 PM Wednesdays with Gaelle This class is for students building present tense narration. <i>Cost: \$115 members/\$165 non-members for six weeks (uses Latitudes 1 books)</i>
Level A1 103 A	Twice a week: 2-4 PM Tuesdays and Thursdays with Olivier Beginners plus ... For those who have some French and are beginning to use past tense. <i>Cost: \$225 members/\$275 non-members for six weeks (uses Latitudes 1 books)</i>
Parlez 1 Beginning Conversation	Once a week: noon-1:30 PM Thursdays with Yuxia This class is designed for beginners or students with a very basic level of French but who would like to work on spoken French only. Grammar is taught in context, but the emphasis is on speaking. <i>Cost: \$115 members/\$165 non-members for six weeks</i>

Level 101 A Beginning French for Spanish Speakers

Once a week: 9-11 AM Saturdays with Graciela

Classes for intermediate students

Communiquez! Intermediate Review and Reinforcement

Twice a week: 5-7 PM Tuesdays and Thursdays with Liz

This class will be a mix of oral and written review of intermediate points essential to French: le passé composé, l'imparfait, le futur et les pronoms. Consider it a French boot camp to whip your spoken and written French into shape!
Cost: \$225 members/\$275 non-members for six weeks

Classes for advanced students (300-level classes)

Grammar and Vocabulary Level 301

Twice a week: 12:30-2:30 PM Mondays and Wednesdays with Yuxia

This class is designed for those who want to work on more advanced structures and increase the range and depth of their French.
Cost: \$225 members/\$275 non-members for six weeks (this class uses Latitudes 3 books)

Special Interest/Skill Classes

Comprendre les actualités! Once a week: Wednesdays from 4-5:30 PM with Liz

Work on building comprehension skills of French at a normal to fast pace. Listen to news broadcasts, French TV and radio clips and real world examples of spoken French. Develop comprehension and speaking skills as you analyze current events in French.

Cost: \$115 members/\$165 non-members for six weeks

Intermediate Literature

Once a week, Thursdays 10:30-noon with Yuxia

This class is for intermediate readers who would like to work in a class setting to read and understand a mid-level work of French literature. The work for this session will be *La Petite Fille de Monsieur Linh* by Philippe Claudel of the Académie Goncourt. The class will strengthen your French reading and speaking skills as you analyze this work. Students must provide their own copy of the novel (ISBN 978-2-253-11554-0)

**Themed Happy Hour
Conversation**

Once a week: Fridays 4:30-6:00 PM with Olivier

Happy Hour is a chance to work on your conversation skills based on a theme or current event article each week. Bring a beverage to drink and enjoy guided conversation in French with other intermediate to advanced speakers.
