#### Classes for beginning students (100-level classes)

Level A1 101 A Once a week: 6-8 PM Wednesdays with Gaëlle

Learn French from the very beginning with this class designed for those new to the language or

those who want to start it up again.

Cost: \$75 for four weeks plus materials (Latitudes 1 Textbook and Workbook \$60 which will be

used into 200-level classes).

**Level A1 101B** Twice a week: 3-5 PM Tuesdays and Thursdays with Olivier

This class is the continuation of the beginning-level class that began in January.

Cost: \$150 for four weeks (uses Latitudes 1 textbook and workbook from previous class).

#### Classes for intermediate students (200-level classes)

**Level A2 201B** Twice a week: 5-7 PM Tuesdays and Thursdays with Liz

This class works on continuing skills developed in the 100-level classes and works on skills

including reflexive verbs and past tenses (le passé composé and the imparfait).

Cost: \$150 for four weeks (this class finishes the Latitudes 1 textbook and workbook from

previous classes)

## Classes for advanced students (300-level classes)

Grammar and Vocabulary Level B2 301

Twice a week: 12:30-2:30 PM Mondays and Wednesdays with Yuxia

This class is designed for those who want to work on more advanced structures and increase

the range and depth of their French.

Cost: \$150 for four weeks (this class continues to use Latitudes 3)

## **Special Interest/Skill Classes**

Parlez Level 2 Once a week: Mondays 4:30-6:00 PM with Olivier

Practice your oral French with an emphasis on pronunciation and form.

Cost: \$75 for four weeks

Parlez Level 3 Once a week: Fridays 1-2:30 PM with Yuxia

This class is designed to get you speaking on a variety of topics with an emphasis on form,

structures, and idiomatic usage.

Cost: \$75 for four weeks

Ecoutez Level 2 Once a week: Tuesdays 1-2:30 PM with Olivier

This class is designed to work on listening comprehension and focuses on understanding native

speakers and authentic material.

Cost: \$75 for four weeks

**Ecoutez Level 3** Once a week: Thursdays 1-2:30 with Olivier

This course uses authentic audio materials to work on understanding oral presentation of

current events as well as everyday spoken French at an advanced level.

Cost: \$75 for four weeks

BYOD Happy Hour Conversation Level 2 and 3

Once a week: Fridays 4:30-6:00 PM with Olivier

Happy Hour is a chance to work on your conversation skills based on a theme or current event article each week. Bring a beverage to drink and enjoy guided conversation in French with other

intermediate to advanced speakers.

#### Littérature française Level B2

Once a week: Thursdays 11:30-1:00 PM with Yuxia

Come discover or rediscover the beauty of French literature. **Un Coeur Simple** de Gustave Flaubert tells the story of a servant girl with a simple mind and a devoted heart. She has no husband, no children, no property but has generous and powerful love. This four-week course will focus on analyzing the characters, discussing themes from the work, and of course, examining the accurate and beautiful language of Flaubert.
